It is vital for all known forms of life, despite not providing food energy or being an organic micronutrient. Due to its presence in all organisms, its chemical stability, its worldwide abundance and its strong polarity relative to its small molecular size; water is often referred to as the "universal solvent". Keeping objects clean, especially if they interact with food or the skin, can help with sanitation. It is a transparent, tasteless, odorless, and nearly colorless chemical substance.
