Fujifilm X100 The Fujifilm X100 is a series of digital compact cameras with a fixed prime lens. Originally part of the FinePix line, then becoming a member of the X The Fujifilm X100 is a series of digital compact cameras with a fixed prime lens. They each have a large image sensor and a 23 mm lens (35 mm equivalent angle of view in full frame format). All six cameras have received generally positive reviews. Originally part of the FinePix line, then becoming a member of the X series from Fujifilm, the X100 series includes the FinePix X100, X100S, X100T, X100F, X100V, and X100VI

The Fujifilm FinePix X100 was initially shown at the Photokina show in September 2010 and was subsequently introduced in February 2011. It was the first model in the Fujifilm X-series of cameras and has since been joined by numerous models. It is superseded by the Fujifilm X100S.

Toyota Mark II Like its predecessor, the X100-series Toyota Mark II was available in multiple trim levels. Every Mark II and Cressida was manufactured at the Motomachi plant at Toyota, Aichi, Japan from September 1968 to October 1993, and later at Toyota Motor Kyushu's Miyata plant from December 1992 to October 2000, with some models also assembled in Jakarta, Indonesia and Parañaque, Philippines as the Cressida. Prior to 1972, the model was marketed as the Toyota Corona Mark II. New for this The Toyota Mark II (Japanese: マークII, Hepburn: Toyota Māku Tsū) is a compact, later mid-size sedan manufactured and marketed in Japan by Toyota between 1968 and 2004. In most export markets, Toyota marketed the vehicle as the Toyota Cressida between 1976 and 1992 across four generations. Toyota replaced the rear-wheel-drive Cressida in North America with the front-wheel-drive Avalon. Toyota dealerships dedicated to particular models

Toyota Chaser In the beginning, Chasers were four-door sedans and hardtop sedans; a two-door coupé was available only for the first generation. Diesel Sedan trim packages

Raffine, XL (turbodiesel) In September 1996, the X100 Chaser replaced the X90 Chaser. It was introduced on the Toyota Mark II (X30) platform and was only available at Japanese Toyota Auto Store dealerships as their top-level model. The product lineup consisted mostly of Avante The Toyota Chaser (Japanese: トヨタチャサー, Hepburn: Toyota Cheisā) is a mid-size car produced by Toyota. The Chaser was produced for six generations; production ceased in 2001 when both it and the Cresta were replaced by the short-lived Verossa e3e48e6b9b

The Cresta was produced for five generations, and production stopped in 2001 when it was merged with the Chaser to form the short-lived Verossa e3e48e6b9b

Film speed Archived from the original Film speed is the measure of a photographic film's sensitivity to light, determined by sensitometry and measured on various numerical scales, the most recent being the ISO system introduced in 1974.
