While computational results normally complement information obtained by chemical. The importance of this subject stems from the fact that, with the exception of some relatively recent findings related to the hydrogen molecular ion (dihydrogen cation), achieving an accurate quantum mechanical depiction of chemical systems analytically, or in a closed form, is not feasible. It uses methods of theoretical chemistry incorporated into computer programs to calculate the structures and properties of molecules, groups of molecules, and solids. The complexity inherent in the many-body problem exacerbates the challenge of providing detailed descriptions of quantum mechanical systems. Education in Poland Primary school lasts eight years (grades 1–8), and students must take a final exam at the end of the eighth grade. Six-year-old children may also begin first grade at the request of their

parents if they attended kindergarten in the preceding school year or have a positive opinion from a psychological and pedagogical counseling center. It is also mandatory for 6-year-old children to receive one year of kindergarten (Polish: przedszkole, literally pre-school) education, before starting primary school (Polish: szkoła podstawowa) at 7 years old.
