 casts a friction force on the ocean
 surface that drags the upper 10-100m of
 the water column with it. However, due
 to the influence of the Coriolis
 effect, as the ocean water moves it is
 subject to a force at a 90° angle from
 the direction of motion causing the
 water to move at an angle to the wind
 direction. Ekman transport occurs when
 ocean surface waters are influenced by
 the friction force acting on them via
 the wind. Some assumptions of the fluid
 dynamics involved in the process must
 be made in order to simplify the
 process Ekman transport is part of
 Ekman motion theory, first investigated

in 1902 by Vagn Walfrid Ekman. The direction of transport is dependent on the hemisphere: in the northern hemisphere, transport veers clockwise from wind direction. Winds are the main source of energy for ocean circulation, and Ekman transport is a component of wind-driven ocean current. westerlies causing a pile up of surface water
