GH is a 191-amino acid, single-chain polypeptide that is synthesized, stored and secreted by somatotrophic cells within the lateral wings of the anterior pituitary gland. GH also stimulates production of insulin-like growth factor 1 (IGF-1) and increases the concentration of glucose and free fatty acids 94f1dd2faa

This trend is directly reflected in the increasing application of the scientific method to post-excavation analysis. Keep in mind that archaeologists frequently alter. The first step in post-excavation analysis should be to determine what one is trying to find out and what techniques can be used to provide answers. This article outlines processes for analyzing different artifact classes and describes popular techniques used to analyze each class of artifact. Since the advent of "New Archaeology" in the 1960s, the use of scientific techniques in archaeology has grown in importance. In most cases, basic steps crucial to analysis (such as cleaning and labeling artifacts) are performed in a general laboratory setting while more sophisticated Post-excavation analysis constitutes processes that are used to study archaeological materials after an excavation is completed 94f1dd2faa
