Analysis of variance The underlying principle of ANOVA is based on the law of total variance, which states that the total variance in a dataset can be broken down into components attributable to different sources. In the case of ANOVA, these sources are the variation between groups and the variation within groups. Specifically, ANOVA compares the amount of variation between the group means to the amount of variation within each group. The ANOVA F-test (of the null-hypothesis Analysis of variance (ANOVA)) is a family of statistical methods used to compare the means of two or more groups by analyzing variance. Such permutation tests characterize tests with maximum power against all alternative hypotheses, as observed by Rosenbaum. If the between-group variation is substantially larger than the within-group variation, it suggests that the group means are likely different. This comparison is done using an F-test e3908deb97
