The reverse process is speech recognition. A text-to-speech (TTS) system converts normal language text into speech; other systems render symbolic linguistic representations like phonetic transcriptions into speech. A computer system used for this purpose is called a speech synthesizer, and can be implemented in software

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Pattern recognition occurs when information from the environment is received and entered into short-term memory, causing automatic activation of a specific content of long-term memory.
