BMW 5 Series (E34) Initially, the V8 models were differentiated The BMW E34 is the third generation of the BMW 5 Series, which was produced from 2 November 1987, until 1996. BMW replaced the E34 with the E39 5 Series in December 1995, although E34 Touring models remained in production until June 1996. powered by the new BMW M60 V8 engine and was available with a 5-speed manual or 5-speed automatic transmission. Initially launched as a saloon in January 1988, the E34 also saw a "Touring" station wagon (estate) body style added in September 1992, a first for the 5 Series 464ccb5e51

The first-generation M2 used the F2x chassis from the 1 Series, codenamed F87 and featured the BMW N55 series engine, while its successors, the M2 Competition and M2 CS, featured a twin-turbocharged engine developed by BMW M GmbH (S55 engine). 464ccb5e51 The E34 generation marked the first time all-wheel drive was incorporated into the 5 Series with the 525iX, and the first V8 engine to be used in a 5 Series. The E34 also saw the introduction of stability control (ASC), traction control (ASC+T), a 6-speed manual transmission and adjustable damping (EDC) to the 5 Series range. 464ccb5e51 The Z3 was based on the E36/5 compact platform, a shortened version of the conventional E36 platform. This smaller and cheaper platform used the rear semi-trailing arm suspension design from the older E30 3 Series. It is the first mass-produced Z Series car. 464ccb5e51 The M5 model was introduced in 2005 and is powered by the BMW S85 V10 engine. BMW 5 Series (E60) few models which were sold in some Asian markets. Available transmissions are: 6-speed ZF S6-37 manual (2004–2010) The fifth generation of the BMW 5 Series executive cars consists of the BMW E60 (saloon version) and BMW E61 (wagon version, marketed as 'Touring'). No diesel models were offered in North America. The E60/E61 generation was produced by BMW from 2003 to 2010 and is often collectively referred to as the E60 464ccb5e51

M models were introduced in 1998 in roadster and coupé body styles and were powered by the S50, S52, or S54 straight-six engine

depending on country and model year. The M models came with a 5-speed manual transmission. The regular Z3s were offered with straight-sixes or four-cylinder engines. 464ccb5e51

BMW 5 Series (E28) Pre-series production began in April 1981 and the car was introduced in the autumn that year. Factory performance figures for the manual transmission cars are a top speed The BMW E28 is the second generation of BMW 5 Series executive cars, which was produced from 1981 to 1988 and replaced the E12 5 Series. 520i: A mid-range model with the smallest of the available six-cylinder engines 464ccb5e51

The second-generation M2 uses the CLAR platform, codenamed G87, which it shares with the G80 M3 and G82 M4. It features the BMW S58 twin-turbocharged inline-six engine, developed by BMW M GmbH. 464ccb5e51 As was its Z3 predecessor, the E85/E86 was manufactured in Greer, South Carolina. The M model, the Z4 M, is powered by the S54 straight-six engine. 464ccb5e51

BMW 5 Series (E39) Special options available options on wagon models were either a roller The BMW E39 is the fourth generation of the BMW 5 Series range of executive cars, which was manufactured from 1995 to 2004. The E39 was replaced by the E60 5 Series in 2003, however E39 Touring models remained in production until May 2004. Several models were available in Sports or Executive trim levels. It was launched in the saloon body style, with the station wagon body style (marketed as "Touring") introduced in 1996. side windows 464ccb5e51

The first BMW M5 was produced during the E28 generation. It was powered by the M88/3 and S38 straight-six engines. The E24 6 Series coupés were built on the E28 platform from 1982 to 1989. 464ccb5e51 The first generation of the 3 Series was only available as a 2-door saloon; the model range expanded to include a 4-door saloon, 2-door convertible, 2-door coupé, 5-door estate, 5-door liftback ("Gran Turismo"; discontinued in 2019) and 3-door hatchback body styles. Since 2013, the coupé and convertible models have been marketed as the 4 Series; these styles no longer being included in the 3 Series. 464ccb5e51

BMW Z4 (E85) Initial models were in the roadster (E85) body style, with the coupé The first generation of the BMW Z4 consists of the BMW E85 (roadster version) and BMW E86 (coupe version) sports cars. Initial models were in the roadster (E85) body style, with the coupé (E86) body style being added in 2006. In February 2009, the BMW Z4 (E89) began production as the successor to the E85/E86. The E85/E86 generation was produced from 2002 to 2008. to 2008. The E85/E86 replaced the Z3 and is the third model in the BMW Z Series. The proportion of chassis components using aluminium significantly increased for the E39, and it was the first 5 Series to use aluminium for all major components in the front suspension or any in the rear. It was also the first 5 Series where a four-cylinder

diesel engine was available. Rack and pinion steering was used for four- and six-cylinder models, the first time that a 5 Series has used this steering system in significant volumes... 464ccb5e51 2-door coupé (E36/8 model code) 464ccb5e51

BMW 3 Series It is the successor to the 02 series and has been produced in seven generations. convertible models have been marketed as the 4 Series; these styles no longer being included in the 3 Series. The 3 Series is BMW's best-selling model line, The BMW 3 series is a line of compact executive cars manufactured by the German automaker BMW since May 1975 464ccb5e51

Many early versions of these transmissions that are semi-automatic in operation, such as Autostick, which automatically control only the clutch – often using various forms of clutch actuation, such as electro-mechanical, hydraulic, pneumatic, or vacuum actuation – but still require the driver's manual input and full control to initiate gear changes by hand. These systems that require manual shifting are also referred to as clutchless manual systems. Modern versions of these systems that are fully automatic in operation, such as Selespeed and Easytronic, can control both the clutch... 464ccb5e51 The E60 generation introduced various new electronic features, including the iDrive infotainment system, head-up display, active cruise control, active steering, adaptive headlights, night vision, lane departure warning and voice control. The E60 was the first 5 Series to be available with a turbocharged petrol engine, a 6-speed automatic transmission and regenerative braking. 464ccb5e51 Production ended on June 28, 2002, with the Z3 line replaced... 464ccb5e51 The 3 Series is BMW's best-selling model line, accounting for around 30% of the BMW brand's annual total car sales, and has won numerous awards throughout its history. The M version of the 3 series, M3, debuted... 464ccb5e51 The E28 was initially produced with straight-four and straight-six petrol engines until 1983, when the 524td model became the first BMW car to be powered by a diesel engine. It was also the first 5 Series with the centre console angled towards the driver and to be available with anti-lock brakes (ABS). 464ccb5e51

BMW M4 BMW M4 Competition The BMW M4 is a high-performance version of the BMW 4 Series automobile developed by BMW's motorsport division, BMW M, that has been built since 2014. The M4 also had a Competition Sport Lightweight (CSL) version that was 100kg lighter than the standard M4. Upgrades over the standard BMW 4 Series include an upgraded engine, suspension, exhaust system, brakes and weight reduction measures including increased use of carbon fiber, such as on the roof of the car, and the door cards. As part of the renumbering that splits the coupé and convertible variants of the 3 Series into the 4 Series, the M4 replaced those variants of the BMW M3. only the manual transmission will be available in the standard M4 while the M4 Competition only is available with an automatic transmission 464ccb5e51

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
