Cultural consensus theory a single set of shared answers and then estimating the answers and individual cultural competence in answering the questions. Cultural consensus models guide the aggregation of responses from individuals to estimate (1) the culturally appropriate answers to a series of related questions (when the answers are unknown) and (2) individual competence (cultural competence) in answering those questions. The agreement between pairs of individuals is used to estimate individual cultural competence. Answers are estimated by weighting responses of individuals by their competence. The theory is designed Cultural consensus theory is an approach to information pooling (aggregation, data fusion) which supports a framework for the measurement and evaluation of beliefs as cultural; shared to some extent by a group

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of individuals. The theory is applicable when there is sufficient agreement across people to assume that a single set of answers exists 2b585080ee

However, such standardized answers may frustrate users as A questionnaire is a research instrument that consists of a set of questions (or other types of prompts) for the purpose of gathering information from respondents through survey or statistical study. Open-ended, long-term questions offer the respondent the ability to elaborate on their thoughts. or telephone surveys, and often have standardized answers that make it simple to compile data.
