Physicist Physicists generally are interested in the root or ultimate causes of phenomena, and usually frame their understanding in mathematical terms. The field generally includes two types of physicists: experimental physicists who specialize in the observation of natural phenomena and the development and analysis of experiments, and theoretical physicists who specialize in mathematical modeling of physical systems. The term physicist was coined by William Whewell (also the originator of the term "scientist") in his 1840 A physicist is a scientist who specializes in the field of physics, which encompasses the interactions of matter and energy at all length and time scales in the physical universe. among other technical fields and titles.
