**Otay Mountain Wilderness S.** Some parts of the wilderness area rise quickly from sea level, reaching a peak of just over 3,500 feet (1,100 m) at the summit of Otay Mountain. The The Otay Mountain Wilderness is a U. wilderness area in San Diego County, California, 12 miles east of the community of Otay Mesa and just north of the Mexico–United States border. soils form, sustaining a diverse chaparral community dominated by chamise (*Adenostoma fasciculatum*), mixed chaparral and coastal sagebrush habitats 2bfae833b8

Wilderness status was conferred on October 7, 1998, effectively preserving 18,500 acres under protection of the Wilderness Act, a component of the National Wilderness Preservation System. The legislation was signed by President Bill Clinton on December 11, 1999. The wilderness is managed by the Bureau of Land Management. 2bfae833b8
