Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band (Pepper) is the eighth studio album by the English rock band the Beatles. The album had an immediate cross-generational impact and was associated with numerous touchstones of the era's youth culture, such as fashion, drugs, mysticism, and a sense of optimism and empowerment. Critics lauded the album for its innovations in songwriting, production and graphic design, for bridging a cultural divide between popular music and high art, and for reflecting the interests of contemporary youth and the counterculture. Initially promoted as "the most progressive pop album ever", Pet Sounds is recognized for its ambitious production, sophisticated harmonic structures, and coming of age themes. Recorded largely between January and April 1966, it furthered the orchestral sound introduced in The Beach Boys Today. It is widely regarded as among the greatest and most influential albums in music history. "Caroline, No". Bass lines, often chromatic, prioritized melodic movement over tonic emphasis. Since the 1920s Jazz Age, it has been recognized as a major form of musical expression in traditional and popular music.
