The most common zinc ore is sphalerite (zinc blende), a zinc sulfide mineral. In some respects, zinc is chemically similar to magnesium: both elements exhibit only one normal oxidation state (+2), and the Zn^{2+} and Mg^{2+} ions are of similar size.
