In April 2013, Banks revealed he had inoperable cancer and was unlikely to live beyond a year. He died on 9 June 2013. Consider Phlebas is Banks's first published science fiction novel, and takes its title from a line in T. S. Eliot's poem The Waste Land. A subsequent Culture novel, Look to Windward (2000), whose title comes from the previous line of the same poem, can be considered a loose follow-up.

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Look to Windward is loosely a sequel to Consider Phlebas, Banks's first published Culture novel. It is Banks' sixth published novel to feature the Culture. The book's dedication reads: "For the Gulf War Veterans". Banks, first published in 2000.
