Hand-to-hand combat The phrase "hand-to-hand" sometimes includes use of melee weapons such as knives, swords, clubs, spears, axes, or improvised weapons such as entrenching tools. While the term "hand-to-hand combat" originally referred principally to engagements by combatants on the battlefield, it can also refer to any personal physical engagement by two or more people, including law enforcement officers, civilians, and criminals. Hand washing If soap and water are unavailable, hand sanitizer that is at least 60% (v/v) alcohol in water can be used as long as hands are not visibly excessively dirty or greasy. Drying of the washed hands is part of the process as wet and moist hands are more easily recontaminated. Additionally, frequent use of hand sanitizer may disrupt the skin's microbiome and cause. However, it is less effective against certain pathogens like norovirus and *Clostridioides difficile* and cannot physically remove harmful chemicals. While hand washing with soap and water is generally preferred, hand sanitizer is a convenient alternative in settings where soap and water are unavailable. Improper use, such as wiping off sanitizer before it dries, can also reduce its effectiveness, and some sanitizers with low alcohol concentrations are less effective b991ab341c
