Data preprocessing Data collection methods are often loosely controlled, resulting in out-of-range values, impossible data combinations, and missing values, amongst other issues. Namely, it requires a high amount of computational power and complexity, even with relatively small Data preprocessing can refer to manipulation, filtration or augmentation of data before it is analyzed, and is often an important step in the data mining process. However, there are some drawbacks to this approach

Preprocessing is the process by which unstructured data is transformed into intelligible representations suitable for machine-learning models.
