Flight with disabled controls Some controls, such as a "yoke" or "stick" move and adjust the control surfaces which affects the aircraft's attitude in the three axes of pitch, roll, and yaw. The Boeing 727 collided with a Cessna 172 single engined aircraft over San Diego, CA. Aircraft are not designed to be flown under such circumstances; however, some pilots faced with

such an emergency have had limited success flying and landing aircraft with disabled controls. The loss of primary control systems in any phase of flight is an emergency. Other controls include those for adjusting wing characteristics (flaps, slats, spoilers) and those that control the power or thrust of the propulsion systems.
