Herbert Eugene Bolton (July 20, 1870 – January 30, 1953) was an American historian who pioneered the study of the Spanish-American borderlands and was a prominent authority on Spanish American history. He originated what became known as the Bolton Theory of the history of the Americas which holds that it is impossible to study the history of the United States in isolation from the histories of other American nations, and wrote or co-authored ninety-four works. A student of Frederick Jackson Turner, Bolton disagreed with his mentor's Frontier theory and argued that the history of the Americas is best understood by taking a holistic view and trying to understand the ways that the different colonial and precolonial contexts have interacted to produce the modern United States. Hedge When clipped and maintained, hedges are also a simple form of topiary. Often they serve as windbreaks to improve conditions for the adjacent crops, as in bocage country. Hedges that are used to separate a road from adjoining fields or one field from

another, and are of sufficient age to incorporate larger trees, are known as hedgerows. A recent study by Emma Coulthard mentioned the possibility that hedgerows may act as guides for moths, like *Acronicta rumicis*. A hedge or hedgerow is a line of closely spaced (3 feet or closer) shrubs and sometimes trees, planted and trained to form a barrier or to mark the boundary of an area, such as between neighbouring properties. like birds and insects 652a899dd3
