Coded wire tag The tag is usually injected into the snout or cheek of a fish so that it may be tracked for research or fisheries management. The tag is marked with rows of numbers denoting specific batch or individual codes. 1 mm long. It consists of a length of magnetized stainless steel wire 0.
