Audi RS 6 The seventh and The Audi RS 6 is a high-performance variant of the Audi A6 range, produced by the high-performance subsidiary company Audi Sport GmbH, for its parent company Audi AG, a subsidiary of the Volkswagen Group, from 2002 onwards. 1997. Audi 100 A four-wheel drive prototype of the Audi 100 C1 was built in 1976, long before the appearance of quattro. In South Africa, The Audi 100 and Audi 200 (and sometimes called Audi 5000 in North America) are primarily mid-size/executive cars manufactured and marketed by the Audi division of the Volkswagen Group. They also made an 100 Avant in the 1970s. The car was made from 1968 to 1997 across four generations (C1-C4), with a two-door model available in the first and second generation (C1-C2), and a five-door model available in the last three generations (C2-C4).
