Few studies have been performed to determine the number of cyanobacteria and microalgae in the atmosphere Aeroplankton (or aerial plankton) are tiny lifeforms that float and drift in the air, carried by wind. Scientists collect them for study in traps and sweep nets from aircraft, kites or balloons. especially quantitative analytical methods. The study of the dispersion of these particles is called aerobiology
