The novel is set in the Final Empire, a tyrannical regime led by the seemingly immortal Lord Ruler. The human population is mainly divided into the nobility and the skaa. In the setting, the magic system of Allomancy allows certain people to digest and burn metals to obtain certain magical powers. While most Allomancers are only able to burn one type of metal, which grants them one of the powers, people known as Mistborn can burn any metal. The skaa are heavily oppressed by the nobility and seen as genetically inferior. In The Final Empire, the half-skaa Mistborn Kelsier and his crew recruit a street urchin named Vin and plot to overthrow the Final Empire.

In 2008, Sanderson started a creative writing podcast with the horror writer Dan Wells and the cartoonist Howard Tayler called Writing Excuses. In mid-2022, Sanderson and Dan Wells started another podcast, Intentionally Blank, which is focused on writing and pop culture. He coined Sanderson's Laws of Magic which popularized the idea of "hard magic" and "soft magic" systems.

== Plot == The Well of Ascension follows the surviving members of Kelsier's crew as they deal with the aftermath of the collapse of the Final Empire. Vin and Elend, who becomes king of the capital city of Luthadel, struggle to exert control over his democratic government while facing a siege from three armies, including one run by Elend's father, Straff. Meanwhile, Sazed investigates a prophecy about the purported Well of Ascension from before the establishment of the Final Empire. The books are organised into four eras with large time skips between, of which the first two are complete and the third is currently being written. The first era (published 2006-2008) is fantasy and chronicles the efforts of a secret group of Allomancers who attempt to overthrow a dystopian empire and establish themselves in a world covered by ash. The second (2011-2022) is a detective story set 300 years later, following the Lawmen Wax and Wayne in their efforts to undermine a criminal ring. The third series will be set in the early computer age with 1980s/1990s technology. The fourth series is planned to be a space-opera.

Brandon Sanderson His best known novels include the Mistborn series and The Stormlight Archive, which are set in the "Cosmere", a fictional universe.
