Secretum Secretorum ('The Secret Book of Secrets'), is a treatise which purports to be a letter from Aristotle to his student Alexander the Great on an encyclopedic range of topics, including statecraft, ethics, physiognomy, astrology, alchemy, magic, and medicine. The earliest extant editions claim to be based on a 9th-century Arabic translation of a Syriac translation of the lost Greek original. Amid the 12th-century Renaissance's Recovery of Aristotle, medieval readers took the ascription to Aristotle at face value. The *Secretum Secretorum* or *Secreta Secretorum* (Latin, 'Secret of secrets'), also known as the *Sirr al-Asrar* (Arabic: كتاب سر الأسرار, lit. Middle Ages or even the most-read.
