By combining multiple geochronological (and biostratigraphic) indicators the precision of the recovered age can be improved. They are also used to date volcanic ash layers Geochronology is the science of determining the age of rocks, fossils, and sediments using signatures inherent in the rocks themselves. Absolute geochronology can be accomplished through radioactive isotopes, whereas relative geochronology is provided by tools such as paleomagnetism and stable isotope ratios 59ac38c7f3

The method was developed in the late 1940s at the University of Chicago by Willard Libby. It is based on the fact that radiocarbon (^{14}C) is constantly being created in the Earth's atmosphere by the interaction of cosmic rays with atmospheric nitrogen. The resulting ^{14}C combines with atmospheric oxygen to form radioactive carbon dioxide, which is incorporated into plants by photosynthesis; animals then acquire ^{14}C by eating the plants. When the animal or plant dies, it stops exchanging carbon with its environment, and thereafter the amount of ^{14}C it contains begins to decrease... 59ac38c7f3
