The institution was known as the Bristol Polytechnic in 1969; it received university status in 1992 and became the University of the West of England, Bristol. The first PISA assessment was carried out in 2000. The triennial repeats follow a similar schedule; the process of seeing through a single PISA cycle, start-to-finish, always takes over four years. Winnetka Plan " While "common essentials" required students to demonstrate mastery to advance, the creative activities allowed students to The Winnetka Plan was an educational experiment held in the Winnetka, Illinois-based Winnetka School District 36. ". Developed by Carleton Washburne, who was the district superintendent (1919-1943), and inspired by John Dewey's work in the University of Chicago Laboratory School, the plan attempted to expand educational focus to creative activities and emotional and social development, using a program of a type that later became known as "programmed instruction. The main approaches to gifted education are enrichment and acceleration. An enrichment program teaches additional, deeper material, but keeps the student progressing through the curriculum at the same rate as other students. For example, after the gifted students have completed the normal work in the curriculum, an enrichment program might provide them with additional information about a subject. An acceleration program advances the student through the standard curriculum faster than normal. This is normally done by having the students skip one to two grades. d95d19673d
