Plant nursery Determination A nursery is a place where plants are propagated and grown to a desired size. The term LT50 (lethal temperature for 50% of a population) is commonly used. Mostly the plants concerned are for gardening, forestry, or conservation biology, rather than agriculture. given level of damage (Siminovitch 1963, Timmis and Worrall 1975).
