Reflector (photography) The area to be In photography and cinematography, a reflector is an improvised or specialised reflective surface used to redirect light towards a given subject or scene. 1956 Subrata Mitra further pioneered the technique with the use of large scale diffusers to match studio lighting with location shooting

Three-point lighting Three-point lighting is a standard method used in visual media such as theatre, video, film, still photography, computer-generated imagery and 3D computer Three-point lighting is a standard method used in visual media such as theatre, video, film, still photography, computer-generated imagery and 3D computer graphics. By using three separate positions, the photographer can illuminate the shot's subject (such as a person) however desired, while also controlling (or eliminating) the shading and shadows produced by direct lighting

Portrait photography The lighting for portraiture is typically diffused Portrait photography, or portraiture, is a type of photography aimed toward capturing the personality of a person or group of people by using effective lighting, backdrops, and poses. A portrait photograph may be artistic or clinical. Frequently, portraits are commissioned for special occasions, such as weddings, school events, or commercial purposes. Portraits can serve many purposes, ranging from usage on a personal web site to display in the lobby of a business. Most lights used in modern photography are a flash of some sort. lighting is often called Paramount lighting

Lighting determines exposure and can be used to create effects such as low-key and high-key lighting, both of which involve the contrast between darker and lighter elements in a scene. Lighting is especially important for monochrome photography, where there is limited to no color information, and exclusively includes the interplay of highlights and shadows.

On through the 1920s, flash photography normally meant a professional A flash is a device used in photography that produces a brief burst of light (lasting around 1/200 of a second) at a color temperature of about 5500 K to help illuminate a scene. Most current flash units are electronic, having evolved from single-use flashbulbs and flammable powders. Flash refers either to the flash of light itself or to the electronic flash unit discharging the light. Modern cameras often activate flash units automatically. The main purpose of a flash is to illuminate a dark scene

Food photography Professional food photography is a collaborative effort, usually involving an art director, a photographer, a food stylist, a prop stylist and their assistants. setup and for test shoots, it is represented by a cardboard or lower-quality food item stand-in. With the advent of social media, amateur food photography has gained popularity among restaurant diners. As a specialization of commercial photography, its output is used in advertisements, magazines, packaging, menus or cookbooks. Rembrandt lighting It is named for the Dutch painter Rembrandt, who occasionally used this type of lighting.
