Rhetoric As an academic discipline within the humanities, rhetoric aims to study the techniques that speakers or writers use to inform, persuade, and motivate their audiences. It is one of the three ancient arts of discourse (trivium) along with grammar and logic/dialectic. Civic virtue Closely linked Civic virtue refers to the set of habits, values, and attitudes that promote the general welfare and the effective functioning of a society. Civic virtue refers to the set of habits, values, and attitudes that promote the general welfare and the effective functioning of a society. Closely linked to the concept of citizenship, civic virtue (virtus) represents, therefore, the disposition of citizens to put the common good (bonum commune) before special interests. The term civility refers to behavior between persons and groups that conforms to a social mode (that is, in accordance with the civil society), as itself being a foundation of society and law. The identification of the character traits that constitute civic virtue has been a major concern of political philosophy

It is often used as a shorthand for youth participation in any many forms, including decision-making, sports, schools and any activity where young people are not historically engaged. Discourse ethics The ethical theory originated with German philosophers Jürgen Habermas and Karl-Otto Apel, and variations have been used by Frank Van Dun and Habermas' student Hans-Hermann Hoppe. Participatory action research PAR contrasts with mainstream research methods, which emphasize controlled experimentation, statistical analysis, and reproducibility of findings. Within a PAR process, "communities of inquiry and action evolve and address questions and issues that are significant for those who participate as co-researchers". PAR emphasizes collective inquiry and experimentation grounded in experience and social history. knowledge for its own sake. It seeks to understand the world by trying to change it, collaboratively and following reflection. Lastly, given its commitment to the research process, PAR overlaps but is not synonymous with action learning, action reflection learning Participatory action research (PAR) is an approach to action research

particular method, theory, or set of political values. In his address, Burawoy contrasts public sociology with what he terms "professional sociology", a form of sociology that is concerned primarily with addressing other academic sociologists.
