Clinical supervision Supervision is a replacement instead of formal retrospective inspection, delivering evidence about the skills of the supervised practitioners. From the earliest times most cultures produced a stream of nurses dedicated to service on religious principles. Both Christendom and the Muslim World generated a stream of dedicated nurses from their earliest days. In Europe before the foundation of modern nursing, Catholic nuns and the military often provided nursing-like services. It took until the 19th century for nursing to become a secular profession. Definitions exhibit slight variation, but they convey the same fundamental meaning:"Field medical care, applied beyond doctrinal planning time-lines".
