Sofa Super Store had set up shop The Charleston Sofa Super Store fire was a firefighting accident that occurred on the evening of June 18, 2007, in Charleston, South Carolina, resulting in the deaths of nine firefighters. located behind the retail space, located at 1807 Savannah Highway in Charleston. The fire, which started in the loading dock of the furniture store, rapidly spread to the main showroom and warehouse, leading to a catastrophic structural collapse. The site was cleared after the fire, and a new fire station was constructed nearby. It was the deadliest firefighter disaster in the US since the September 11 attacks. The building had no fire sprinkler system
