Safety-related systems are those that do not have full responsibility for controlling hazards such as loss of life, severe injury or severe environmental damage. Defibrillation Defibrillation delivers a dose of electric current (often called a counter-shock) to the heart. They are mostly used in the operating room and Defibrillation is a treatment for life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias, specifically

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ventricular fibrillation (V-Fib) and non-perfusing ventricular tachycardia (V-Tach). Although not fully understood, this process depolarizes a large amount of the heart muscle, ending the arrhythmia. A heart which is in asystole (flatline) cannot be restarted by defibrillation; it would be treated only by cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and medication, and then by cardioversion or defibrillation if it converts into a shockable rhythm. A device that administers defibrillation is called a. myocardium. Subsequently, the body's natural pacemaker in the sinoatrial node of the heart is able to re-establish normal sinus rhythm. Manual internal defibrillators deliver the shock through paddles placed directly on the heart
