Nine Inch Nails Its members are the singer-songwriter, multi-instrumentalist and producer Trent Reznor and his frequent collaborator, Atticus Ross. After disagreements with TVE over how the album would be promoted, the band signed with Interscope Records and released the EP Broken (1992), followed by the albums The Downward Spiral (1994) and The Fragile (1999). Reznor was previously the only permanent member of the band until Ross became an official member in 2016. Written, arranged, and performed by Reznor, Nine Inch Nails’s first album Pretty Hate Machine Nine Inch Nails, commonly abbreviated as NIN (stylized as NIW), is an American industrial rock band formed in Cleveland, Ohio in 1988. In line with the band's previous material, the record features

introspective songwriting influenced by Reznor's addiction to alcohol and drugs and subsequent sobriety. The album generated three singles: "The Hand That Feeds", "Only", and "Every Day Is Exactly the Same", the latter of which was released as an accompanying remix EP. The album was supported by the Live: With Teeth tour.

The nail gun was designed by Morris Pynoos, a civil engineer by training, for his work on Howard Hughes' Hughes H-4 Hercules (known as the Spruce Goose). The wooden fuselage was nailed together and glued, and then the nails were removed.
