After the Iranian Revolution, the Islamic Republic established its slogan as "neither East nor West. At the start of the war, the Soviets declared a policy of strict neutrality towards the two countries, at the same time urging a negotiated peace. The war was inconvenient for the Soviet Union, which had aimed to ally itself with both Iran and Iraq. According to the national security experts, the role of Pakistan in the war, however, was based more on maintaining a delicate balance. During the conflict, Pakistan sought to portray as strictly "neutral" but cultivated friendly relationship with Iran. In a state visit paid by Pakistani President General Zia-ul-Haq to the United Kingdom in the mid-1980s, he correctly predicted that the conflict "will end up in a military stalemate". 8abf293449

Iran-Iraq War Active hostilities began with the Iraqi invasion of Iran and lasted for nearly eight years, until the acceptance of United Nations Security Council Resolution 598 by both sides. There were also fears among the Iraqi leadership of Saddam Hussein that Iran, a theocratic state with a population predominantly composed of Shia Muslims, would exploit sectarian tensions in Iraq by rallying Iraq's Shia majority against the Ba'athist government, which was officially secular but dominated by Sunni Muslims.
