Despite indications from Twain that he did not want his autobiography to be published for a century, he serialized selected chapters during his lifetime; in addition, various compilations were published during the 20th century. The *Autobiography* comprises a collection of anecdotes and ruminations rather than a conventional autobiography. However, it was not until 2010 that the first volume of a comprehensive three-volume collection, compiled and edited by The Mark Twain Project of the Bancroft Library at University of California, Berkeley, was published. imposed by Twain on his own autobiography's release, which expired in 2010.
