Nutrient-rich solutions can promote the growth of microorganisms over time, so that microbial activity can alter the chemical composition of the solution, potentially Ammonium chloride is an inorganic chemical compound with the chemical formula  $\text{NH}_4\text{Cl}$ , also written as  $[\text{NH}_4]\text{Cl}$ . It is mainly used as fertilizer and a flavouring agent in some types of liquorice. In its naturally occurring mineralogic form, it is known as salammoniac.
