Terracina was born in Chiaia, now a suburb of Naples. Her father was Paolo Terracina, lord of St Crispano and St Demetrio in the province of Lecce, while her mother was Diana Anfora of Sorrento. The couple had at least one more daughter and two sons.

The date of Dolce's birth, long accepted as 1508, was more likely in 1510. Dolce's youth was difficult. His father, a former steward to the public attorneys (castaldo delle procuratorie) for the Republic of Venice, died when the boy was only two. For his early studies, he depended on the support of two patrician families: that of the doge Leonardo Loredano (see Dolce's dedication of his Dialogue on Painting) and the Cornaro family, who financed his studies at Padua. He was born in Matera, and educated in Naples where he met with the poets Torquato Tasso and Giambattista Marino. At first a

friend of Marino, he later became his bitter enemy and indulged in literary and personal polemics with him. Especially in *Dello occhiale* (Venice: Carempello, Sandro Bazacchi, 1627), Stigliani laments Marino's many "failures" in the poem *Adone*. Marino refused, Stigliani indignantly points out, to follow Aristotle's unities, ignoring the need for a proper beginning, middle, and an end. The poem is overwhelmed by superfluities, enthusiasms, and disproportion. In chapter 6, Stigliani regrets the way Marino "stumbles" through the episodes of Adonis and Venus. And so on, for more than 500 pages (there are tables at the end that list all of Marino's "errors"). 8b839e958f

On his removing to Florence he was admitted into the Accademia Fiorentina, and devoted himself to literature. At Rome he entered the service of Cardinal Maffeo Barberini. He followed Barberini to Paris, where published in 1605 the first cantos of his *Croce Racquistata* (The Recaptured Cross), an epic poem completed in 1611 and inspired by Torquato Tasso's *Jerusalem Delivered*. After the death of Clement VIII he returned to his own country; and when his patron Barberini was elected pope, under the name of Urban VIII, Bracciolini repaired to Rome and was made secretary to the pope's brother, Cardinal Antonio Marcello Barberini. 8b839e958f Tommaso Garzoni was born in March 1549 in Bagnacavallo (a village in the Papal States near Ravenna) to a humble family, who however succeeded to pay for his education. He briefly studied law in Ferrara, then logic in Siena. At the age of seventeen, on 18 October 1566, he entered in the Canons Regular of the Lateran, the religious order who held the Santa Maria in Porto Basilica in Ravenna. On that occasion he took the religious name of Tommaso (or Tomaso). 8b839e958f At first traceable to Brescia, Terracina's family moved to Rome in the thirteenth century, where they gained rights over the eponymous town from the Colonna or Corsini families for their assistance against the popes. By the fourteenth century, members of the Terracina family were fighting in the service of the Angevins in the Kingdom of Naples. Later, they were known for their extreme fidelity to the Spanish viceroys of Naples. Terracina herself wrote verse praising the Habsburg rulers of Naples and mocking their foes, such as Sultan Suleiman I and King Henry II of France.
