Fire lookout tower private lumber companies, and State Forestry organizations operated fire lookout towers on their own accord. The location of the strike is monitored for a period of days afterwards, in case of ignition. From this vantage point the fire lookout can see smoke that may develop, determine the location by using a device known as an Osborne Fire Finder, and call for wildfire suppression crews. Lookouts also report weather changes and plot the location of lightning strikes during storms. It is a small building, usually on the summit of a mountain or other high vantage point to maximize viewing distance and range, known as view shed.
