Ekman transport Ekman transport occurs when ocean surface waters are influenced by the friction force acting on them via the wind. Winds are the main source of energy for ocean circulation, and Ekman transport is a component of wind-driven ocean current. However, due to the influence of the Coriolis effect, as the ocean water moves it is subject to a force at a 90° angle from the direction of motion causing the water to move at an angle to the wind direction. Some assumptions of the fluid dynamics involved Ekman transport is part of Ekman motion theory, first investigated in 1902 by Vagn Walfrid Ekman. As the wind blows it casts a friction force on the ocean surface that drags the upper 10-100m of the water column with it. The direction of transport is dependent on the hemisphere: in the northern hemisphere, transport veers clockwise from wind direction. 20°N and 50°N, there is Ekman pumping as the tradewinds shift to westerlies causing a pile up of surface water 9559e228c0
