Various classes of road exist, from two-lane local roads with at-grade intersections to controlled-access. Cargo may be transported by trucking companies, while passengers may be transported via mass transit. Commonly defined features of modern roads include defined lanes and signage. King Street was named in honour of King George III by John Graves Simcoe when it was laid out The following is a list of the east-west expressways and arterial thoroughfares in Toronto, Ontario, Canada. The city is organized in a grid pattern dating back to the plan laid out by Augustus Jones between 1793 and 1797. In other words, major north-south roads are generally perpendicular to the Lake Ontario shoreline and major east-west roads are generally parallel to the lake's shoreline. Most streets are aligned in the north-south or east-west direction, based on the shoreline of Lake Ontario. Minor streets with documented history or etymology are listed in a separate section. given position is a win or a draw, and to know the technique for playing it. The crux of this endgame is whether or not the pawn can be promoted (or queened), so checkmate can be forced.
