He was the founding chairman of International Institute of Information Technology, Hyderabad. He was the founding director of the Robotics Institute at Carnegie Mellon University. He was the first person of Asian origin to receive the Turing Award, in 1994, sometimes known as the Nobel Prize of computer science, for his work in the field of artificial intelligence. He was instrumental in helping to create Rajiv Gandhi University of Knowledge Technologies in India, to cater to the educational needs of the low-income, gifted, rural youth. college.
