In this astroturfing technique for public relations and media manipulation, online Chinese companies employ people to post on social media to change public opinion. They post news, comments, gossip and disinformation on online platforms like Weibo, WeChat and Taobao, China's eBay-like platform. It has been developed into an industry in which a company specializing in internet water armies can earn 7. negative reviews about a product or some gossip targeting a person, they must pay the Internet water army to screen and delete the negative comments
