The two operators each operated their own pair of rail tracks down that thoroughfare, which The Market Street Railway Company was a commercial streetcar and bus operator in San Francisco. Once the largest transit operator in the city, the company folded in 1944 and its assets and services were acquired by the city-owned San Francisco Municipal Railway.
