TPR Storytelling The method works in three steps: in step one the new vocabulary structures to be learned are taught using a combination of translation, gestures, and personalized questions; in step two those structures are used in a spoken class story; and finally, in step three, these same structures are used in a class reading. Proponents TPR Storytelling (Teaching Proficiency through Reading and Storytelling or TPRS) is a method of teaching foreign languages. TPRS lessons use a mixture of reading and storytelling to help students learn a foreign language in a classroom setting. Throughout these three steps, the teacher will use a number of techniques to help make the target language comprehensible to the students, including careful limiting of vocabulary, constant asking of easy comprehension questions, frequent comprehension. assign additional reading activities such as free voluntary reading, and there have been several easy novels written by TPRS teachers for this purpose 438987dc29

Formative assessment His subsequent Formative assessment, formative evaluation, formative feedback, or assessment for learning, including diagnostic testing, is a range of formal and informal assessment procedures conducted by teachers during the learning process in order to modify teaching and learning activities to improve student attainment. 1968 in the book Learning for Mastery to consider formative assessment as a tool for improving the teaching-learning process for students. It typically involves qualitative feedback (rather than scores) for both student and teacher that focuses on the details of content and performance. The goal of a formative assessment is to monitor student learning to provide ongoing feedback that can help students identify their strengths and weaknesses and target areas that need work. in students using specific reading strategies, such as Questioning, Clarifying, Summarizing, and Predicting, to actively construct meaning from text. making educated guesses about the content of the text before reading, activating prior knowledge and setting the stage for comprehension 438987dc29
