Race (human categorization) The authors conclude that "caution should be used when using geographic or genetic ancestry to make inferences about individual phenotypes" Race is a categorization of humans based on shared physical or social qualities into groups generally viewed as distinct within a given society. Modern science regards race as a social construct, an identity which is assigned based on rules made by society. The term came into common usage during the 16th century, when it was used to refer to groups of various kinds, including those characterized by close kinship relations. The concept of race is foundational to racism, the belief that humans can be divided based on the superiority of one race over another. for the same answer. By the 17th century, the term began to refer to physical (phenotypical) traits, and then later to national affiliations. While partly based on physical similarities within groups, race does not have an inherent physical or biological meaning af095fda7e

While ammonoids and coleoids are monophyletic clades with Nautiloids are a group of cephalopods (Mollusca) which originated in the Late Cambrian and are represented today by the living Nautilus and Allonautilus. Fossil nautiloids are diverse and species rich, with over 2,500 recorded species. They flourished during the early Paleozoic era, when they constituted the main predatory animals af095fda7e
