Urim and Thummim The Urim and Thummim are sometimes connected by scholars with cleromancy (with divination by casting lots), although it is equally likely no casting was physically. Assyriologist William In the Hebrew Bible, the Urim (Hebrew: אֲרִימִים 'Ūrīm, "lights") and the Thummim (Hebrew: תִּמְמִים Tummīm, "perfection" or "truth") are elements of the hoshen, the breastplate worn by the High Priest attached to the ephod, a type of apron or garment. Any natural process that is not completely random and any observable pattern in any medium can be said to convey some amount of information. Information is not knowledge itself, but the meaning that may be derived from a representation through interpretation. Whereas digital signals and other data use discrete signs to convey information, other phenomena and artifacts such as analogue signals, poems, pictures, music or other sounds, and currents convey information in a more continuous form. At the most fundamental level, it pertains to the interpretation (perhaps formally) of that which may be sensed, or their
