Examples of the most studied classes of algebraic varieties are lines, circles, parabolas, ellipses, hyperbolas, cubic curves like elliptic curves, and quartic curves like lemniscates and Cassini ovals. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. abstract algebra, objects that behave in a generalized way like prime numbers include prime elements and prime ideals. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order
