Mental health nurses work with people across the lifespan in hospitals, community services, primary care, residential services, schools, correctional settings and people's homes. Depending on their education and legal scope of practice, their work may include comprehensive assessment, nursing diagnosis and care planning, psychosocial interventions, medication administration and monitoring, physical health care, crisis intervention, suicide prevention, care coordination, health education and advocacy. Across different countries, crisis intervention following mass trauma events such as natural disasters relies on trained professionals who provide immediate support, coping strategies, and resource coordination to help individuals navigate psychological distress. Intervention process often begins with an assessment. In countries such as the Czech Republic, crisis intervention is an individual therapy, usually lasting four to six weeks, and includes assistance with housing, food, and legal matters. Long waiting times for resident psychotherapists and in Germany, explicit exclusions of couples therapy and other therapies complicate implementation. In the United States, licensed professional counselors (LPCs) provide mental health care to those in need. Licensed professional counselors focus on psychoeducational techniques to prevent a crisis, consultation to individuals, and research effective therapeutic treatment to deal with stressful environments.

While many in the global mental health field study psychosocial interventions developed by or in collaboration with locals, due to constraints in resources like personnel and time, prescribing medication is often seen as more cost-effective. In recent years, there has been an emphasis on creating community-based, scalable, and sustainable...
