Quantitative designs approach social phenomena through quantifiable evidence, and often rely on statistical analyses of many cases (or across intentionally designed treatments in an experiment) to create valid and reliable general claims. Qualitative designs emphasize understanding of social phenomena through direct observation, communication with participants, or analyses of texts, and may stress contextual subjective accuracy over generality.

Outline of logic Logic investigates and classifies the structure of statements and arguments, both through the study of formal systems of

inference and the study of arguments in natural language. Logicians study the criteria for the evaluation of arguments. One of the aims of logic is to identify the correct (or valid) and incorrect (or fallacious) inferences. The scope of logic can therefore be very large, ranging from core topics such as the study of fallacies and paradoxes, to specialized analyses of reasoning such as probability, correct reasoning, and arguments involving causality.
