Air warfare of World War II Both Britain and the U. S. Germany Air warfare was a major component in all theaters of World War II and, together with anti-aircraft warfare, consumed a large fraction of the industrial output of the major powers. Simultaneously, they built tactical air forces that could win air. By contrast, Britain and the United States took an approach that greatly emphasized strategic bombing and (to a lesser degree) tactical control of the battlefield by air as well as adequate air defenses. component in all theaters of World War II and, together with anti-aircraft warfare, consumed a large fraction of the industrial output of the major powers. Initially, they were used mostly for reconnaissance. World War II Tanks and aircraft played major World War II or the Second World War (1 September 1939 – 2 September 1945) was a global conflict between two coalitions: the Allies and the Axis powers. After the Allied victory, Germany, Austria, Japan, and Korea were occupied, and German and Japanese leaders were tried for war crimes. World War II is the deadliest conflict in history, causing the death of 70 to 85 million people, more than half of whom were civilians. Tanks and aircraft played major roles, enabling the strategic bombing of cities and delivery of the first and only nuclear weapons ever used in war. Nearly all of the world's countries participated, with many nations mobilising all resources in pursuit of total war. Millions died in genocides, including the Holocaust, and by massacres, starvation, and disease. The battleship was a capital ship built in the first half of the 20th century. At the outbreak of war, large fleets of battleships—many inherited from the dreadnought era decades before—were considered one of the decisive forces in naval warfare. There were two engagements between battleships in the Pacific theatre and three in the Atlantic theatre. Battleships were the most heavily protected ships afloat, nonetheless sixteen were sunk or crippled by bombs... c19f045d50 Over the course of the war the United States Navy grew tremendously as the United States was faced with a two-front war on the seas.
