Occupational therapist Human occupations include activities of daily living, work/vocation, play, education, leisure, rest and sleep, and social participation. OTs have training in the physical, psychological, and social aspects of human functioning deriving from an education grounded in anatomical and physiological concepts, and psychological perspectives. They enable individuals across the lifespan by optimizing their abilities to perform activities that are meaningful to them ("occupations"). OTs do this by advocating for individuals and empowering them. Some claim higher public support for the licensing of professions whose activities could be a health or safety threat to the public, such as practicing medicine, and doctors require occupational licenses in most developed countries. However, some jurisdictions also require licenses for a much wider range of professions, such as florists and hairdressers. Some studies find consumers are more responsive to reviews than to occupational licensing status.

Occupational injustice As a particular application of social justice, occupational injustice occurs when a

person is denied, excluded from or deprived of opportunity to pursue meaningful occupations or when unchosen occupations are imposed upon them thus limiting life satisfaction. Through this participation, occupational rights contribute to fulfillment and self-actualization. The construct of occupational rights stems from human rights but focuses on the inherent right of individuals to participate in occupations, construed as their personally meaningful and goal-directed use of time. Occupational therapy Occupational therapy is based on the assumption that engaging in meaningful activities, also referred to as occupations, is a basic human need and that purposeful activity has a health-promoting and therapeutic effect.

Ergotherapy is derived from the Greek *ergon* which is allied to work, to act and to be active. occupation. The primary goal of occupational therapy is to enable people to participate in the activities of everyday life. Occupational science, the study of humans as 'doers' or 'occupational beings', was developed by inter-disciplinary scholars, including occupational therapists, in the 1980s.
